LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF THE YEAR 2026

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 125 OF THE VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING OBSTRUCTION IN STREETS**

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Waverly as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 125, Article II, Section 125-7 shall hereby be amended by deleting the current definition of "Street" and replacing it with:

STREET: Includes all areas within the street right-of-way, including but not limited to the street, sidewalk and berm.

Section 2. Chapter 125, Article II, Section 125-8 shall hereby be amended by adding a new subsection C as follows:

- C. Board permission granted under this Section shall be based upon a determination of whether the obstruction unreasonably interferes with the safe and efficient flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic, or is otherwise detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare.

Section 3. Separability

The provisions of this local law are separable and if any provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, or inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, clauses, sentences, subsections, words, or parts of this local law or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this local law would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional provision, clause, sentence, subsection, word or part had not been included therein, and as if such person or circumstance, to which the local law or part thereof is held inapplicable, had been specifically exempt therefrom.

Section 4. Repealer

All Ordinances, Local Laws and parts thereof inconsistent with this Local Law are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
